FACILITY The USA Swimming certified competition pools are 8-lane, 25 yard course featuring nine foot lanes separated by non-turbulent lane lines, Paragon starting blocks and a minimum pool depth of 6 feet. A Colorado Electronic Timing system and an 8-lane scoreboard will be used. Warm-up and warmdown lanes will be available. Seating for 1000 spectators. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.

NCS Meet Announcement Template, September 23, 2012

SAFETY	The NCS Safety Program is in effect for this meet. Coaches are advised to closely supervise their swimmers at all times. NO running or horseplay will be tolerated.
RACING STARTS	Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by an USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by an USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
RULES	This meet will be conducted in accordance with the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, except where rules therein are optional and exceptions are stated. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.
ELIGIBILITY	All swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Swimmers must be registered prior to entry deadline. Entries listed as "Registration Applied For" will not be accepted. There will be no on deck registration available at this meet.
SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES	ATOM welcomes all swimmers with disabilities as described in the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 105, to participate in our meets. Coaches entering swimmers with disabilities that require any accommodations are required to provide advance notice in writing to the Meet Director by the entry deadline accompanying their meet entry file, including the need for any personal assistants required and/or registered service animals. Failure to provide advance notice may limit ATOM ability to accommodate all requests.
ENTRIES	Entries submitted in Hy-tek format require no hard copy entry forms. Email is preferred for electronic entries however, disks are also acceptable. A completed and signed Entry Summary Sheet (included in the announcement) and payment in full must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by the entry deadline. A swimmer's age on the first day of the meet will determine their age for the entire meet. ATOM's entries will be entered first and then accept teams/entries in the order received, until the four hour rule is reached. Entries received thereafter will be returned immediately. All relay only swimmers including alternates must be listed and pay the NCS Travel Fund surcharge.
ENTRY LIMITATIONS	Swimmers may swim a maximum of 4 individual events per day, maximum 8 individual events total.
ENTRY VERIFICATION	An email will be sent to the person submitting the entry confirming receipt of the entry within 48 hours of receipt.

ENTRY DEADLINES

The Meet Entry Coordinator must receive entries by the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. No late entries will be accepted. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Referee. There will be no on deck entries.

SEEDING	The conforming time standard for this meet is short course yards. Swimmers will be seeded and swim from slowest to fastest unless otherwise indicated. All non-conforming times will be seeded last in rank order
CHECK-IN	 A positive check-in, will be located at the clerk of course and will be required for the following events: 500 free 400 IM Check in for event will be as stated in the Deadline and Meeting Summary Swimmers that fail to check in will be scratched from the event and not seeded In the positive check-in events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded, and fails to complete in said event, shall be barred from his/her next individual event.
SCRATCHES	There will be no penalty for scratching pre-seeded events at the block.
SCORING	 All scoring will be on a sixteen (16) place basis. Individual events: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2
AWARDS	Ribbons will be awarded to the top 8 finishers in each age group, 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14 and Senior.
RESULTS	Results will be posted on ATOM's website within 24 hours of the meets conclusion. At the conclusion of the meet, teams may obtain Hy-tek backups either on a memory stick or via email attachment.
COACHES	All coaches on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming. Meet Management will require all coaches to show proof of certification/registration and shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. There will be a coach/general meeting at the date and time listed in the Deadline and Meeting Summary. Other meetings may be held at the meet referee's discretion. Meet Management requests that at least one coach representative from each team attend all coaches meetings.
OFFICIALS/TIMERS/	There will be a need for officials. ATOM welcomes and encourages anyone

VOLUNTEERS willing to volunteer to contact the Meet Referee by email prior to the meet or sign in once you arrive at the meet. All officials on deck must be registered and certified with USA Swimming and will be required to show proof of certification/registration. Officials shall prominently display their registration cards at all times while on deck. Any official's assistance will be greatly appreciated and will help to ensure a great meet for the swimmers. Official briefings will be held in the hospitality area and will begin one hour prior to the sessions start. **HOSPITALITY**/ There will be a hospitality area open to all coaches and officials. Concessions **CONCESSIONS** will be available. WARM-UP In accordance with USA Swimming guidelines, there will be a published warm-up procedure for all swimmers and coaches attending the meet. The Marshall will ensure all teams, coaches, and swimmers follow all warm-up procedures. Meet Management reserves the right to change warm-up times according to the number of entries. During the competition, there will be lanes available for continuous warm-up/down. There is to be no diving or horseplay in this area. As a team entered in this meet, upon entry you are verifying that all of the WAIVER/RELEASE swimmers and coaches listed on the enclosed entry are registered with USA Swimming.
